The Family Tree Detective: A manual for tracing your ancestors in England & Wales (4th Ed.) by Colin D. Rogers

This is the best guide to basic genealogy of English & Wales I have ever come across. This is a must read (&/or buy) for ALL who wish to teach &/or understand the fundamentals of English genealogy.

Scotland During the Plantation of Ulster 1600-1699 - Volume 3 – The People of Lanarkshire by David Dobson

This is the third in this series by David Dobson, the first two being for Dumfries & Galloway & then Ayrshire.

The People of the Scottish Burghs – People of Dundee 1600-1799 - Parts 1 & 2 by David Dobson

This is the first in a new series by David Dobson, the previous ones on Aberdeen, Paisley & Banff & Elgin/Moray were published by his wife Frances McDonnell.

German Parish Register Map Guides, Volume 24 - Thuringen by Kevan M. Hansen

This is Volume 24 out of a projected set of 46. For any one seriously interested in German genealogy &/or teaching even beginning German genealogy this series is fundamental. The beginning section of each volume is a must read for anyone attempting genealogy in the area of Germany covered by that volume. MPFHC receives each new volume as it is published. The MPFHC also has a full set of Roger Minert's Place Name Index books & the Atlantic Bridge Series, both Old & New, as well as Meyer's Orts, in hardcopy, 1913 edition. Uncapher & Herrick's German Maps & Facts for Genealogy (on the Main Reference Shelves), as well as MPFHC's German-European Map Collections are Key References for both beginners & helpers/teachers.

IRISH CD - Handran's Townlands in Poor Law Unions 1885, originally published by Alexander Thom for HMSO, republished 1997 by George B. Handran
